The Muriel Duckworth Memorial Bursary

The Nova Scotia Federation of Labour in partnership with Higgins General Insurance is pleased to offer the Muriel Duckworth Memorial Bursary, in the amount of \$1000.00. This bursary will be offered to a full-time student who will be attending university or trade school/community college for the first time or as a returning student. For 60 years, Muriel Duckworth worked as a tireless crusader and an advocate for social justice and change. Muriel was involved with numerous organizations supporting peace initiatives, social reform and educational development in Nova Scotia and across Canada. Muriel played an integral role in the evolution and development of Canadian women's social and peace movements on local, provincial and national levels. Sometimes her role included that of singer in the well-known protest group "The Raging Grannies" who were the highlight of many rallies and demonstrations over the years. Sister Duckworth died in 2009, at the age of 100.
