**EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY:**

We will be filling two Asphalt Inspector 2 positions and one Structures Inspector 2 position per Construction Area. This opportunity is open to Weigher/Checker/Inspector employees who have conducted inspections of asphalt and/or structures within the last two years, as verified by Project Engineers. To be eligible, employees must complete designated training and pass a competency test. Positions will be filled based on seniority among those deemed competent. Selected employees will retain their current work period designation.

**TRAINING OPPORTUNITY:**

Inspector 2 Training for Asphalt and/or Structures is available to Weigher/Checker/Inspector employees. Participants who successfully complete this training and pass the required testing will be added to a competency list. Employees on this list may temporarily fill an Inspector 2 position in case of an absence or operational necessity, receiving compensation at the Inspector 2 rate for the duration of the assignment.

**Additional Information:**

Priority for the Inspector 2 positions will be given to those with experience in asphalt and structural inspections. If these positions are not initially filled, offers will be extended based on seniority to those who have passed the required training and testing.

**Qualifications of Inspector 2:**

- Applicants must be a Weigher/Checker/Inspector employee.
- High School Diploma or GED or an acceptable equivalent education, training, and experience.
- Good oral communication, record keeping and observational skills, and an aptitude for mathematics.
- Must have an ability to comprehend industry specifications and project documents and drawings.
- Must have good physical dexterity and condition as duties demand working for long hours in all types of weather conditions and geographic terrains.
- Must have a valid driver's license and access to a reliable motor vehicle.
- Must have completed the mandatory training required for the Asphalt or Structures Inspector 2 position.
- Must pass the written test for the Asphalt or Structures Inspector 2 position with a passing grade of 60% or higher.
