Signs are designed using computer software and various materials such as plywood, extruded aluminum panels, utility grade aluminum, and reflective materials. Various tools are used during production and assembly, including but not limited to; table saws, radial arm saws, and metal shears. Completed signs are prepared for shipping and loaded into trucks using a fork lift, or by hand. As the Sign Technician, you will also ensure the overall cleanliness of the Sign Shop by performing light janitorial duties.

Qualifications and Experience

Grade 12; or a combination of education, training, and experience will be considered. You must have a strong mathematical aptitude, good written and verbal communication skills including spelling and grammar skills, and ability to use computers for entering and searching inventory data.

Required training includes table saw, radial cut off saw, silk screening and overhead crane.
