- Applicants must pass the Department of Public Works operator examination administered by an EQII as defined in Article 14.03 to be deemed qualified to operate or eligible for training for 07 Truck & Trailer.
- Knowledge of the pre-trip inspection program and equipment servicing procedures is required.
- Knowledge of the department's Health, Safety and Environment Program is required.

The successful applicant(s) will work under the Operations Supervisor, carry out 07 Truck & Trailer operations on provincial highways and adhere to established Safe Work Practices and Job Procedures, including but not limited to 07 Truck & Trailer operations.

In accordance with Article 14.03 at the end of the training and or testing process, employees who are deemed qualified are expected to operate the equipment when required.
