- Knowledge of the Department's Health, Safety and Environment Program is required.
- · Applicants will also be required to achieve Fitness for Work standards which meet Class I medical requirements.
- Applicants must have a Class I license

The successful applicant(s) will work under the Operations Supervisor, carry out Summer Grader operations on provincial highways and adhere to established Safe Work Practices and Job Procedures.
